Research Article on K-SMART published in National e-Governance Compendium



A paper authored by Dr. Mini B. Nair, Professor & Nodal Officer, Centre for Good Governance and Aswin T.K., Research Associate, Centre for Good Governance has been published in the prestigious National Compendium of e-Governance Initiatives.

The compendium, themed "Viksit Bharat: Civil Service and Digital Transformation," is a publication by the Department of Administrative Reforms & Public Grievances (DARPG), Government of India.

The paper, titled "K-SMART: Reimagining Local Governance in Kerala through Digital Transformation," provides an in-depth analysis of the landmark initiative by the Government of Kerala. It highlights how K-SMART is digitizing the service delivery and administrative functions of Local Self Government Institutions (LSGIs), aiming to provide real-time, transparent and efficient governance.

Exposure Visit of Nagaland Civil Service Officers

A team of 15 probationers from the Nagaland Civil Service visited the Institute of Management in Government (IMG) as part of a six-day training-cum-study tour. The visit aimed to familiarize the participants with Kerala's best governance practices and to provide opportunities for interaction with the organizers and beneficiaries of innovative development initiatives in the state.

institutions, including the Vellar Art and Craft Village, Kudumbashree units, and the Central Tuber Crops Research Institute (CTCRI). These field visits offered the participants valuable exposure to Kerala's model of participatory governance and community-driven development.

A team of four faculty members from Nagaland Administrative Training Institute, along with the Director of the Nagaland Administrative Training Institute, accompanied the delegation, facilitating discussions and ensuring a meaningful learning experience throughout the programme.

Training Programme for Government Law Officers

Court of Kerala who served as the primary resource Their deliberations covered crucial persons. aspects of law and practice, particularly focusing on Drafting Pleadings and Defending Writ Petitions before the High Court and also the Legal impact of India's 2025 Maritime Statutes on Kerala's Coastal Environment. The sessions were highly interactive, providing participants with valuable insights into judicial expectations and best practices in litigation. The session was further graced by the presence of Sr.Adv. Gracious Kuriakose, Additional Director General of Prosecutions, Kerala who delivered the felicitation address. The programme concluded with the valedictory address delivered by the State Attorney, Sri N. Manoj Kumar, who emphasized the pivotal role of law officers in safeguarding the rule of law and in effectively representing the interests of the State with integrity and professional



competence. He lauded the initiatives of IMG in organising such capacity-building programmes and encouraged the participants to translate the knowledge and insights acquired during the training into their professional practice.

Studies (NCESS). The second day featured sessions on Incident Detection and Response in Cybersecurity by Balu M, and Cybersecurity in Daily Life: Common Threats and Mitigations by Rasic A. Azeez, Security Engineer, CERT-K, Kerala State IT Mission, offering participants practical insights into threat management and prevention. The final day included

sessions on Cybersecurity Laws, Regulations, and Cyber Resilience by Sruthi Krishna G, Research Associate, KSAAC, Digital University Kerala, and Cyber Hygiene and Proactive Cyber Defense by Rasic A. Azeez. The programme concluded with a valedictory function led by the Course Director, where participants expressed appreciation for the relevance and practical value of the sessions. Overall, the training enhanced participants' awareness of digital security practices, enabling them to strengthen their organizational cyber defenses and adopt proactive measures to mitigate potential cybersecurity risks.
